Our job is to work with you, and make you feel better about your writing than when you entered the Center. We work with our students to base the session on their needs. You run the session—we are just there to help you.

All students are welcome! Whether you are beginning a draft, or you want us to reread your final paper before you turn it in, we are eager to have you!

Here are some ways in which you can change the session to help your needs:

~We have a separate room for times when the Center is too loud or crowded—if you think you will get distracted, let us know at any time throughout the session and we can move rooms.

~We also have a closed off space in the corner if you would rather stay within the center, but be within a private space.

~If you work better thinking aloud, you can talk and we can write notes!
