## **Project Mission and Overview:**

The mission of the Puerto Rican Tiple Construction Project is to rescue this Puerto Rican folkloric string-instrument, which can be traced back to the Sixteenth Century, from disappearing, as well as to:

- Introduce teaching tools to individuals from the community (regardless of age, nationality, ethnicity, color, and gender) in the rudiments of stringed instrument making;
- Provide a first step introduction into the much broader field of traditional stringed-instrument making, and fashioning of more complex instrument such as the Puerto Rican Cuatro;
- Provide participants with information about the instrument's cultural history, its music, and place in Puerto Rican society.

The workshops will be taught by William Cumpiano, a master instrument builder and scholar of Puerto Rican stringed instruments. The project consists of 6 workshop days, running from August 15-20 from 12:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m., and at the end of the week each student will leave with his/her own completed Tiple. There is a \$100 registration fee, which covers the cost of materials, though there are also limited scholarships available for those who are not able to afford the registration fee (see more information below in Scholarship section). *Students must commit to attending all 6 sessions.* 

The 2016 Puerto Rican Tiple Construction Workshop is sponsored and organized by the Trinity College Studio Art Program, Center Church, The Center for Global and Urban Studies at Trinity College, and The Puerto Rican Cuatro Project.
